

Points to Note

1. Applicants must be Hong Kong residents, and their HK identity document(s) should be submitted alongside their application. Applicants should be 16 years old or above, and should fulfill the academic requirements.
2. Please return the completed application form, in person or by post, to the Centre for Advanced and Professional Studies (CAPS).
3. The University reserves the right to decide whether an applicant is admitted or not, and holds the final decision to cancel a module / programme in case of insufficient registration. If a module / programme is cancelled by the University due to any reason, tuition fees paid will be refunded by crossed cheque.
4. Tuition fees paid will not be refunded in all cases unless the module / programme is cancelled by the University. Upon registration, no change of class, transfer of fee or fees refund would be allowed.
5. All classes take place as scheduled unless typhoon signal no.8 or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is hoisted, or class cancellation is announced by the Education Bureau. Students have the responsibility to pay attention to announcements on the media during unstable weather.
